The McHenry County Historical Society & Museum is located in the historic 1870 native limestone Union School building, the space includes a 1948 gymnasium and a modern stone addition constructed in 1992.

In addition to the main museum building, the site features several preserved historic structures: the 1843 Gannon Log Cabin, the 1895 West Harmony School, and a 1950 modern tourist cabin.

The research library houses books, pamphlets, photographs, postcards, maps, journals, vertical files and newspapers, plus other historical documents.
