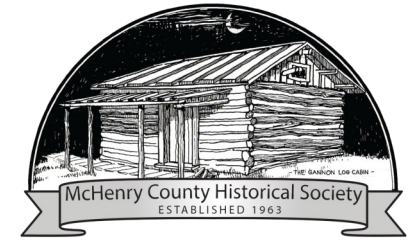

We have restored and preserved the 1843 Gannon log cabin, 1867 Pringle School, 1886 Seneca Town Hall, 1895 West Harmony School, 1898 Riley Country Church, and a 1950 Tourist cabin.
