ELIGIBILITY: The Nancy Fike Scholarship is open to graduating seniors or first-year college students who have graduated from a McHenry County high school and who are, or plan on, **studying history, education or social sciences**. Applicants must have a **minimum high school GPA of 3.0**. Children and grandchildren of MCHS Board members and staff are not eligible.

INSTRUCTIONS: The application packet must be complete and arranged in the order listed below. All original transcripts, and other required documents, must be received by MCHS by **April 10th, 2026**, in a single digital package (PDF). TOPIC:

July 4, 2026, marks the 50th anniversary of the opening of the McHenry County Historical Society's History Museum.

In a 500–1,000-word essay, explain how county and local history organizations support democracy and teach the values of good citizenship. Think about how these groups help people learn about their community's past, get involved in local events, make informed choices about public issues, and experience history through museums.

Additionally, share a personal story about a time you visited a museum that was meaningful or exciting for you. What made it special, and how did it help you understand history, your community, or what it means to be a good citizen? Finally, tell us your own preference(s) for learning about history through museum gallery exhibits, interactive displays, or online resources?

If the conditional scholarship winner does not fulfill the above requirements, MCHS reserves the right to award it to another worthy applicant.
